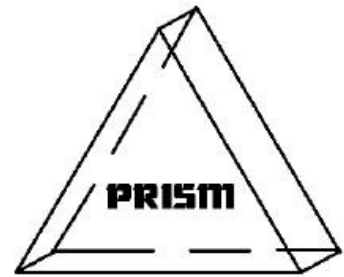

Don Johnson, P.E. is the Board Investigator for the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers. Prior to taking this position in October 2003, Mr. Johnson was employed by Chemstrand, Monsanto and Flexsys for 35 years in positions of increasing responsibility. He has held various positions ranging from designer to engineer to engineering manager. He is a 1974 graduate of the University of Alabama in Huntsville with a degree in Fluid and Thermal Engineering. Don is a registered professional engineer in Alabama and West Virginia he has an extensive plant design and construction background.

Mr. Johnson is past president of the Appalachian Construction User's Council and a long time member of that council. He is a Life member of ASME.

Lesley Rosier-Tabor, P.E., is the Executive Director of the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers.
